Summer is approaching fast and we're gearing up for another season of the Purgatory Adventure Camp for Kids (**PACK**)! If your child is **5 years old by June 7th, 2010 through 12 years old** and likes the outdoors, PACK is a fun addition to the summer.

The PACK is an exciting day camp based at Purgatory. We offer a great lineup of activities including hiking, rock climbing, ropes course, and more. We give kids time to be kids, to be creative, to explore and to be social. One of the best things for you is that your child's schedule can be flexible. You can register for camp for any amount of days, whatever fits your schedule. You can expect your children to come home with great recounts of the day, new friends and a sense of accomplishment. The enclosed materials describe the program in full detail.

This summer, our PACK program will start two weeks before the mountain opens for summer activities. We did this to better match our program's start date with the release date of 9-R school district. Since the lifts will not be running during the first two weeks of PACK, we have scheduled two "Field Trips". These "Field Trips" will find us exploring some of our surrounding areas near the resort. Locations in the past have been Cascade Creek & Purgatory Flats. All field trips will be close to DMR property. We will pick participants up at the mountain (our final stop) and venture to the field trip destination. Your child will need all the same items as they do for a regular day of camp at the mountain.

During July we scheduled one more "Field Trip." On Wed. July 7th, by popular demand.

As tradition holds, the last day of PACK (Fri. Aug 20th), we will have a BBQ. The PACK Program provides lunch that day. Please still send children with water & snacks on the last day if attending.

PACK Information 2010

A Typical Day at PACK

Buses leave town at 8:00 am and make several stops on the way to the resort (see schedule below for bus stops and times). After arriving at the resort, we divide into groups and get ready to spend the day outside. At 10:00 we ride up the lift and start our daily activity: rock climbing, hiking, teamwork, or ropes course. We break for lunch around 12:00 pm. After lunch campers continue with the daily activity or head back to the base area to have fun. At 3:00 pm everyone gathers in the Base Area. Counselors make sure the children have gathered all of their personal belongings, and by 3:10 pm. the bus departs from the resort and heads to town (see schedule on next page).



PACK Activity Schedule

Daily activities are planned for each week, including hiking, climbing, ropes course and teamwork exercises. Daily activities run on a rotating schedule, so if your child is only at camp two days a week, he/she will be able to participate in all of the major daily activities. **Activities may change based on weather, logistics and the preference of camp participants.**

PACK Activities: AGE APPROPRIATE ACTIVITIES FOR SUCCESS IS OUR GOAL!

Hiking: Hiking days offer a chance to have a great time exploring Purgatory Mountain. Based on the weather forecast and the general energy level of the children, destinations are chosen on a day-by-day basis. Before the hike starts, Team Leaders plan out which aspects of the mountain to discover, including animal tracks, plant species, animal signs, watersheds, bugs, flowers, and more. Once campers make it to the destination everyone enjoys lunch. After lunch campers play a game and then head back to the Base Area.

Climbing: Most children have climbed on a climbing wall, but how many have climbed on real rock? Purgatory is riddled with short limestone rock faces with a wide array of climbing difficulty. Our trained team leaders ensure that all climbing is closely supervised and every participant is successful.

Teamwork: Everybody wins during teamwork day. Counselors facilitate group tasks to achieve a common goal. Activities include: scavenger hunts, mysteries, the human knot, trust, fort building, orienteering, and more.

Ropes Course: Purgatory's low ropes course features several stations with ropes about three feet off the ground. Children are challenged mentally and physically to complete as many of the ropes as they can. All ropes are supervised and spotted by a Team Leader.

SUMMER ACTIVITIES WARNING, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY & WAIVER OF CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS.

1. The person who is assisting with or taking part in any or all of the various activities available at DSC/Purgatory, LLC, dba Durango Mountain Resort, including but not limited to riding the **ALPINE SLIDE**, riding the **SCENIC CHAIRLIFT**, **HIKING AND CLIMBING IN MOUNTAIN TERRAIN** whether self-guided or with guide, playing **MINI GOLF**, playing **DISC GOLF**, climbing the **CLIMBING WALL**, climbing on **NATURAL ROCK**, playing **BASKETBALL**, **PING PONG**, **VOLLEYBALL** and/or **HORSESHOES**, using the **ROPES COURSE**, using the **BUNGEE TRAMPOLINE**, playing in the **BOUNCE HOUSE**, participating in **FIELD TRIPS** and playing in the **PLAYGROUND**, shall be referred to hereinafter as "Participant". The "Undersigned" means only the Participant when the Participant is age 18 or older OR it means both the Participant and the Participant's parent or legal guardian when the Participant is under the age of 18. The Undersigned agree and understand that any or all of the various activities, for any purpose (hereinafter the "Activity"), can be **HAZARDOUS AND INVOLVES THE RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY AND/OR DEATH** which could occur from these activities, the risks of loading, riding and unloading the aerial lifts, changing weather conditions, loose gravel and dirt, rocks, uneven terrain, collisions with natural, man-made and other objects or persons, dangers from flying objects whether man-made or natural from other participants or yourself, and all of the other risks that are included in participation in various outdoor activities in a mountain environment.

As to **RIDING THE ALPINE SLIDE**, I understand that such an activity includes the **HAZARDS AND RISKS** that the sled is solely a user controlled device, that the **SLED DOES TIP OVER OR MAY LEAVE THE TRACK**, that **HIGH SPEEDS** may be reached if the user allows the sled to do so, that the materials of the track and the sled can cause cuts, abrasions, etc., that injuries do occur and that, by my signature below, I **VOLUNTARILY ASSUME ALL RISKS of any INJURY OR DEATH RESULTING FROM MY PARTICIPATION IN THIS SPORT AND AGREE TO KEEP THE SLED UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES AND TO FOLLOW ALL POSTED AND VERBAL INSTRUCTIONS.** I also agree to remain alert and to act in a careful and prudent manner at all times to safeguard myself as much as possible.

2. The Undersigned agree and understand that there are dangers and risks associated with participating in the Activity and that falls, **INJURIES AND/OR DEATH** may result from engaging in the Activity. The Undersigned agree and understand that **risks include, but are not limited to, the following:**

Use of equipment, equipment failure, improper use of equipment by Participant or others, slipping, falling, tripping, becoming tangled in a rope, collisions with others, collisions with hard surfaces, varying surfaces of the Activity area, splinters, changing weather conditions, lightning, falling debris, transportation to and from the venue, and mental distress from exposure to any risks

3. The Undersigned acknowledge and understand that the description of the risks listed above are not complete and that participating in the Activity, whether or not described, may be dangerous and may also include risks which are inherent and/or which cannot be reasonably avoided without changing the nature of the Activity. By signing this document, the Undersigned recognize that property loss, injury, serious injury and death are all possible while participating in the Activity. **RECOGNIZING THE RISKS AND DANGERS, THE UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTAND THE NATURE OF THE ACTIVITY AND VOLUNTARILY CHOOSE FOR PARTICIPANT TO PARTICIPATE IN AND EXPRESSLY ASSUME ALL RISKS AND DANGERS OF THE ACTIVITY, WHETHER OR NOT DESCRIBED ABOVE, KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, INHERENT OR OTHERWISE.**

4. Additionally, in consideration for allowing the Participant to participate in the Activity, **THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREE NOT TO SUE** DSC/Purgatory, LLC, dba Durango Mountain Resort or any of their respective successors in interest, affiliated organizations and companies, insurance carriers, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, officers, directors, and shareholders (each hereinafter a "Released Party") for any property damage (including but not limited to equipment damage), injury or loss to Participant, including death, which Participant may suffer, arising in whole or in part out of Participant's participation in the Activity. By agreeing not to sue, the Undersigned **are releasing any right to make a claim or file a lawsuit against any Released Party.** Also, the **UNDERSIGNED AGREE TO HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE EACH AND EVERY RELEASED PARTY FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY** and/or claims for injury or death to persons or damage to property arising from Participant's participation in the Activity, **including, but not limited to, those claims based on any Released Party's alleged or actual NEGLIGENCE or BREACH of any CONTRACT and/or express or implied WARRANTY.**

5. By execution of this Agreement, the Undersigned also **AGREE TO DEFEND AND INDEMNIFY/REIMBURSE** each Released Party from any and all claims of the Undersigned and/or a third party arising in whole or in part from Participant's participation in the Activity.

6. In consideration for allowing Participant to participate in the Activity, the Undersigned **AGREE THAT ANY AND ALL CLAIMS** for injury and/or death arising from the Participant's participation in the Activity shall be **GOVERNED BY COLORADO LAW** and **EXCLUSIVE**

JURISDICTION of any claim shall be the **DISTRICT COURT OF LA PLATA COUNTY, COLORADO** or in the **FEDERAL COURT FOR THE STATE OF COLORADO**.

7. In the case of a minor Participant, the Undersigned parent or legal guardian acknowledges that he/she is not only signing this Agreement on his/her behalf, but that he/she is also signing on behalf of the minor and that the minor shall be bound by all the terms of this Agreement. Additionally, by signing this Agreement as the parent or legal guardian of a minor Participant, the parent or legal guardian understands that he/she is also waiving certain rights on behalf of the minor that the minor otherwise may have. The Undersigned parent or legal guardian agrees that but for the foregoing, the minor Participant would not be permitted to participate in the Activity.

8. By signing this Agreement without a parent or legal guardian's signature, Participant, under penalty of fraud, represents that he/she is at least 18 years of age. If signing as the parent or guardian of a minor Participant, signing adults represent that they are a **legal** parent or guardian of the minor Participant.

9. The Undersigned understand and acknowledge that this Agreement is a contract and shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any part of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be an enforceable contract between the parties. It is the Undersigned's intent that this Agreement shall be binding upon the assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors and personal representatives of the Undersigned.

10. The undersigned gives FULL PERMISSION for DMR to use ANY AUDIO OR VISUAL MATERIALS of said minor(s) taken during the DMR KIDS MOUNTAIN SCHOOL PROGRAMS and by signing below, I am releasing the use of any audio or visual materials taken, or on file, and for any uses by DMR of me or my child(ren). I understand that all said images and sound recordings shall constitute the property of DMR, solely and completely.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THE FOREGOING ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT AND UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT I AM RELEASING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS THAT OTHERWISE MAY EXIST.
